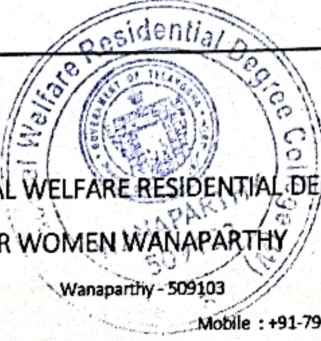

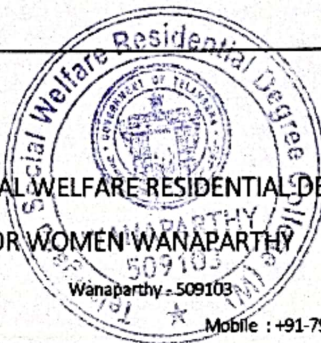
1. In view of the Covid Pandemic, all the colleges have been closed; the Government and Universities of the state has advised for online classes.

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
