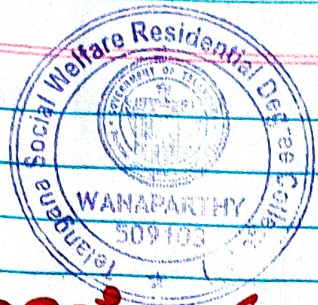

Introduction to Anti Ragging Cell (ARC)

Anti-Ragging committee is the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a culture of ragging free environment in the college campus. Anti-Ragging committee is involved in defining strategies and action plan for curbing the menace of ragging in the college by adopting an array of activities.

Objectives of ARC:

Ragging is a humiliating social crime. Its foremost objectives of ARC are:

- To prevent and protect the student community from being ragged or indulging in the act of ragging.
- To bring awareness among the students about the ill effects of ragging, its impact on human life and consequence of involvement in the act of ragging.
- To receive the complaints and resolve them through the ARC.
- To initiate legal action when required considering the intensity of ragging instances.

Duties of Ragging Grievant:

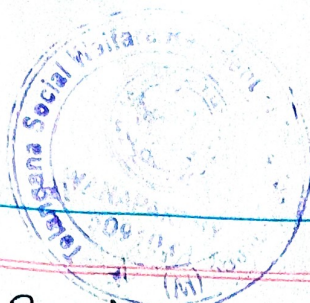
1. A written complaint has to be submitted to the Anti-Ragging committee (ARC) describing the ragging instance completely with date, time and place.

2. ensure compliance with the provision of these regulations and any law for the time being in force concerning ragging and to deal and act promptly with the incidents of ragging brought to its notice.
3. conduct enquiry and observing the campus monitor the welfare of fresh students in to the campus.

Administrative action in the event of Ragging:-

The Institution shall Punish the student found guilty of ragging after the procedure and in the manner prescribed here in under:-

- The ARC committee shall take an appropriate decision in regard to punishment
- The ARC depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt will follow up the punishment based on the committee decision.





Anti-Ragging committee was conducted under the chairmanship of the Principal sakida discussed following agenda points are
